The exchange program with the University of Mannheim is only available to students of psychology, political science, and sociology.

This document lists the courses at the ASPIRE Exchange partner university that have already been approved for an IU equivalent course. We will update this list when new equivalencies are established. See the date at the bottom for when this list was last updated and know that the list is subject to change as new information becomes available.

Students can enroll in many courses beyond those listed below. Any other course taken on the exchange program will provide generic, 100-level credit by default (a.k.a. “undistributed credit”). Undistributed credit counts toward the total number of credits needed to graduate, but it doesn’t fulfill Gen. Ed., CASE, or Major Requirements. To get specific credits for courses that do not yet have an established equivalency, the student requests a course equivalency evaluation. However, if a course at a partner university is not similar to a course at IU, it will remain undistributed, which is not necessarily a problem.

To request a course equivalency evaluation, refer to the [Course Equivalency How-To Guide](#) on the [ASPIRE Exchanges](#) website. Contact the [academic advisor](#) in the most relevant department at IU to provide a syllabus for the course at the partner university.

Mannheim credit conversion

1.5 -2 ECTS = 1 IU Credit

2.5-3 ECTS = 1.5 IU Credits

3.5-4 ECTS = 2 IU Credits

4.5-6 ECTS = 3 IU Credits

6.5-8 ECTS = 4 IU Credits

8.5-10 ECTS = 5 IU Credits
